This matter was opened to the New Jersey Board of Pharmacy upon the receipt of Joseph Amendolaro's application for a reciprocal license to engage in the practice of pharmacy in the State of New Jersey, based on his current, valid pharmacy license in the State of Pennsylvania.

Respondent appeared before the Board on July 12, 2000 and testified under oath in response to questions from the members of the Board regarding his prior suspension of his Pennsylvania license. Having considered the testimony of respondent and the documents received from the Pennsylvania State Board of Pharmacy, the Board has determined that issuing a license to respondent with conditions precedent and subsequent to that issuance, will be adequately protective of the public.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent shall successfully complete the New Jersey Jurisprudence Exam.
2. Respondent shall complete a 500 hour practicum under the supervision of a Board certified preceptor.
3. Upon respondent's documentation of his successful completion of the above requirements 1 and 2, respondent shall be issued a license to engage in the practice of pharmacy in this State.
4. Prior to January 1, 2002, respondent shall inform all preceptors and/or permit holders, prior to commencing the practicum set forth in paragraph 2 or employment as a pharmacist, that he has been barred from participating in the State of Pennsylvania Medicaid Program until December 31, 2001.
