ORDERED:

1. The license to engage in master plumbing issued to Joseph R. Fichner, Jr. shall be and hereby is revoked.
2. Upon satisfying all financial and suspension obligations imposed by the Board's order of August 28, 1997, Joseph R. Fichner, Jr. shall have leave to seek reinstatement of his license on written application to the Board demonstrating his fitness for relicensure.
3. The within order shall become final thirty (30) days following entry hereof, unless during such time Joseph R. Fichner, Jr. submits a written statement setting forth reasons why the within order should not become final. Upon receipt of such statement, the Board will decide what, if any, further action may be appropriate.


TO THE CLERK OF THE SUPERIOR COURT OF NEW JERSEY:

Pursuant to said Order the above-named individual is obligated to pay the following sums to:


