



rendered by a nun, respondent billed the complainant's health benefits program with his signature as the physician or supplier of services without disclosing that the treatment was rendered by another practitioner and without disclosing the name and professional practice status of the practitioner. It appears to the Board that the aforementioned conduct constitutes the use of misrepresentation or deception within the meaning of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(b), professional misconduct within the meaning of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e), and a violation or failure to comply with the provisions of Board regulations at N.J.A.C. 13:42-10.10, 10.11, and 10.12 concerning financial arrangements with clients and billing and therefore violative of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(h).

It appearing that the respondent desires to resolve this matter without recourse to formal proceedings and for good cause shown;


IT IS ON THIS 31<sup>st</sup> DAY OF OCTOBER, 2000,

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. The respondent is hereby assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000.00 for the conduct set forth above. Said civil penalty shall be submitted by certified check or money order made payable to the State of New Jersey and submitted to the Board of Psychological Examiners no later than the first day of the month following the entry date of this Order.

2. Respondent shall make restitution by submitting a certified check or money order made payable to the complainant in the amount of \$150.00 to the Board of Psychological Examiners no later than the first day of the month following the entry date of this Order.


