This matter was opened to the New Jersey Board of Accountancy by receipt of information that respondent had pled guilty on or about September 2, 1997 to a one count Felony Information in the United States District Court, District of new Jersey to wit: respondent conspired in the failure to report cooperative income of Pro-Data Corporation; as President of the corporation for the purpose of evading the payment of Federal Income Taxes, for the years 1992 and 1993.

Respondent wishing to voluntarily surrender his license to practice accountancy and acknowledging that the above described plea pursuant to N.J.S.A.45:1-21(f) constitutes conviction of a

crime involving moral turpitude or of a crime relating adversely to the accounting profession in the sue of fraud, dishonesty, deception and misrepresentation contrary to N.J.S.A.45:1-21, (b) and (e), and the parties having agreed and consented to the resolution of this matter without the necessity of formal administrative proceedings available to the Board, and respondent understanding the terms and impact of the within Order, and it therefore appearing that due cause exists for the entry of the within Order,

IT IS ON THIS 4th DAY OF *December*, 2000,


ORDERED:

1. That respondent shall surrender at the Office of the State Board of Accountancy, 124 Halsey Street, Newark, New Jersey, his license to practice accountancy in the State of New Jersey, both the original certificate and the most current renewal. Such surrender shall be made contemporaneously with her receipt of the within Order and shall be with prejudice to reinstatement.

2. That upon the surrender of his license to practice accounting, respondent shall cease and desist the practice of accounting in the State of New Jersey and shall not hold himself out as a CPA of this State.

3. Respondent shall pay costs to the Board for the use of the State upon receipt of an Affidavit of Costs from the Executive Director.
