

seven days following receipt of the letter. Although respondent signed for the letters, indicating that the certified mail was received, no response to the Board was forthcoming.

(Copy of certification attesting to the above facts annexed hereto and made a part hereof.)

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The facts as stated supra demonstrate clearly that respondent has failed to cooperate with an investigation of the Board, in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.2.

2. Respondent is subject to sanctions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(h), in that he failed to comply with an act or regulation administered by the Board.

Based on the foregoing findings and conclusions, a Provisional Order of Discipline was entered on October 24, 2000 assessing a civil penalty of \$2,500 against respondent for failure to cooperate with the Board's investigation, and directing that respondent forward his pressure seal to the Board. A copy of the Order was forwarded to respondent's last known address by means of both regular and certified mail. The Provisional Order was subject to finalization by the Board at 5:00 p.m. on the 30th business day following entry unless respondent requested a modification or dismissal of the stated Findings of Fact or Conclusions of Law by submitting a written request for modification or dismissal setting forth in writing any and all reasons why said findings and conclusions should be modified or dismissed and submitting any and all documents or other written evidence supporting respondent's request for consideration and reasons therefor.

Although the record reflects that the Provisional Order was served upon respondent, no response has been received to date. Accordingly, the Board considered the matter, determined further proceedings were not necessary, and that the Provisional Order should be made final.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this *7th* day of *Feb*, 2001,


ORDERED that:


Office files indicate that Anthony Fontana was issued license #9914 on February 7, 1990.
