TO PRACTICE ACCOUNTANCY IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY	:	

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Accountancy upon the receipt of information that Alan S. Gottlich, CPA pled guilty in November 1999 to one count of Making False Statements to the U.S. Department of Housing and Development (HUD), in U.S. District Court, Tampa, Florida, to wit: filing for asset/management and accounting fees in violation of HUD regulations. Respondent was sentenced to a three (3) month period of house arrest and a ~~five~~ ^{THREE (3)} (5) year probation. *RG*

It appearing that respondent acknowledges the above described conviction and sentence, and further acknowledges that the conviction constitutes a crime of moral turpitude and a crime that relates adversely to the profession of accountancy, and the parties

being desirous of resolving this matter without the necessity of further formal proceedings, and respondent having agreed to the terms and entry of the within Order, and for good cause shown,

IT IS ON THIS 15th DAY OF March, 2001,

ORDERED AND AGREED:

1. That respondent's license as a certified public accountant in the State of New Jersey shall remain on inactive status and respondent shall not be issued an active license prior to the completion of the criminal probation.

2. While on inactive status, respondent shall not engage in the practice of public accounting in the State of New Jersey in any manner or form, nor hold out to the public as an accountant, a certified public accountant, or in any manner that could be confused with those titles.
