

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers (hereinafter "the Board") upon receipt of information that Respondent supervised the individuals who were performing plumbing work while these individuals were not employed by Respondent. Respondent is represented by Howard A. Matalon, Esq

Respondent has acknowledged that he supervised individuals who were performing plumbing and that those individuals were not his employees. Respondent has further represented that he was not aware that by doing so, he was acting in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:32-3.4. Respondent has further represented that, upon being

advised by the Board that it finds that he was acting in violation of the regulation, Respondent immediately ceased supervising persons who were not his own employees.

These facts establish a basis for disciplinary action pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(h). It appearing that Respondent desires to resolve this matter without admission as to a violation of law and without recourse to formal proceedings, and there being no indication that Respondent, a licensed master plumber, did not actually supervise the performance of the plumbing work, Respondent having represented that he immediately ceased supervising persons who were not his employees upon being advised by the Board that it finds that such conduct constituted a violation of law, and certifying to this representation by his consent to the entry of this order, and acknowledging that if such representations are knowingly false, he is subject to penalty, and the Board having found a technical violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(h) and deeming a penalty less than the maximum is appropriate in light of the mitigating circumstances set forth above, and for good cause shown:


HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent shall cease and desist from supervising persons in the performance of plumbing work unless those persons are his employees.

2. Respondent is hereby assessed civil penalties, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-22 and N.J.S.A. 45:1-25, in the amount of \$5,000.00 ^{paid.} which shall be submitted no later than ⁴⁵ ~~10 business~~ days from the entry of this Consent Order, by certified check or money order made payable to the State of New Jersey and shall be sent to Barbara Cook, Executive Director, Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers, 124 Halsey Street, Sixth Floor, P.O. Box 45008, Newark, New Jersey 07101, Subsequent violations will subject respondent to enhanced penalties pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-25. IM




