2. Respondent shall pay a \$2,500 civil penalty and the costs of the use of the State in this matter to the State Board of Accountancy upon submission of an Affidavit of Costs from the Board's Executive Director.

3. Respondent specifically agrees and acknowledges that upon any further violation of this Order, the Superior Court of the State of New Jersey may after a summary hearing enter an Order restraining respondent from such violations upon the affidavit of the Attorney General and with ^{short} notice to respondent.
