Interim Consent Order

Respondent, Glenn Morgenstern, M.D., License No. MA 050135, a physician specializing in internal medicine and geriatric medicine, is licensed in the State of New Jersey. Respondent has admitted in an October 27, 1999 deposition in a civil suit, and during an appearance before the Preliminary Evaluation Committee on December 5, 2001, to one instance of an inappropriate sexual encounter occurring over the course of an afternoon in his patient's home. In order for this Board to make a final determination in this

matter, respondent consents to submit to a diagnostic evaluation from a Board approved center for sexual disorders. Further, until a final determination is made as to respondent's fitness to safely practice medicine, respondent must be monitored by a licensed health care professional when treating female patients.

ORDERED:

1. In order for the Board to make a determination as to respondent's fitness to practice, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-22(e), respondent shall obtain a diagnostic evaluation from a diagnostic center for sexual disorders which has been pre-approved by the Board. Any evaluations, recommended treatments and records from this evaluation shall be provided to the Board. Respondent shall bear the cost of said evaluation. Respondent shall ensure that the report of said evaluation shall be submitted to the Board within one month of the entry of this Order.


2. Until the Board makes a final determination in this matter, respondent shall be monitored by a licensed health care professional, regulated by the Division of Consumer Affairs and approved by the Board. Respondent shall bear the cost of the monitoring. Such monitoring shall consist of a chaperone being present each time that respondent treats a female patient. Such

chaperone shall signify her presence by initialing the entry in the patient chart.

3. Respondent shall ensure submission to the Board of all medical records and reports from treating therapists for the past five (5) years.


