THIS MATTER was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners (hereinafter the "Board") upon its receipt of information from State Farm Insurance Company which revealed that patient C.C. sought psychiatric treatment from Grigory Rasin, M.D., (hereinafter the "Respondent"), following an automobile accident on or about July 17, 1994. The information disclosed that on various dates from August 1994 through November 1994, Respondent billed State Farm Insurance Company for an initial psychiatric evaluation

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using CPT code 90801 and eight(8) psychiatric follow-up sessions using CPT code 90844. The information further revealed that the initial psychiatric evaluation and the eight (8) psychiatric follow-up sessions were conducted by a non-physician clinician employed by Respondent.

Respondent appeared before a Preliminary Evaluation Committee of the Board on March 28, 1998 and testified that he never met patient C.C. but that a different psychotherapist with his office evaluated and treated C.C. under his supervision.

The Board finds that Respondent misrepresented himself to the insurance carrier as the treating physician for C.C. when, in actuality, he supervised a clinician who treated the patient. Respondent's conduct described above constitutes a violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21 (b) and (e).

Respondent being desirous of resolving this matter without further formal proceedings and the Board finding the within disposition is adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare, for the reasons expressed herein and other good cause having been shown,

IT IS on this 19th day of April, 2002

ORDERED AND AGREED, that:

1. Respondent, Grigory Rasin, M.D., is hereby reprimanded for the conduct described herein.

2. Respondent shall pay investigative costs in the amount of \$ 1,559.24 upon entry of the within Order.

3. Said payments for investigative costs shall be made payable to the Board of Medical Examiners and shall be submitted to William Roeder, Executive Director of the Board of Medical Examiners, P.O. Box 183, Trenton, New Jersey 08625-0183, upon entry of this Order.

4. Respondent shall, within the twelve months following entry of this Order, take and successfully complete an ethics course and a billing course approved in advance by the Board. Successful completion means that all sessions were attended, all assignments were properly and appropriately completed, and a passing grade was achieved which was unconditional and without reservations.
