CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy upon receipt of information that respondent Juan Molyneau was convicted in the United States District Court, Eastern District of New York, of the crime of conspiracy to distribute prescription legend drugs without a license. (Copy of Judgment of Conviction and attachments annexed hereto and made a part hereof). The following sentence was ordered: three (3) years probation, three (3) months

of which he is to be confined to his residence, 300 hours of community service, and \$1,100.00 fine.

It appearing that respondent acknowledges the above described conviction, and further acknowledges that the conviction constitutes a crime of moral turpitude and a crime that relates adversely to the profession of pharmacy, and respondent being desirous of resolving this matter without the necessity of further formal proceedings, and all parties having agreed to the terms and entry of the within Order, and for good cause shown,


IT IS THEREFORE on this *9th* day of *October*, 2002,

ORDERED AND AGREED, that the license of respondent Juan Molyneau, R.P. to practice pharmacy shall be revoked on entry of this Order, with no right to apply for reinstatement prior to his completion of the criminal term of probation.

ORDERED AND AGREED, that Respondent shall not engage in the practice of pharmacy in the State of New Jersey or in any other jurisdiction in any manner or form, including but not limited to the following: he shall not handle, order, inventory, compound, count, fill, refill or dispense any drug; he shall not engage in the acceptance of any prescription in person or by telephone; he shall not advise or consult with any person concerning the properties and actions of drugs; he shall not handle or dispense prescriptions; he shall not type labels for prescriptions or enter information on profile cards.

ORDERED AND AGREED, that respondent shall, by execution of the within Order, surrender his original wall certificate, his wallet certificate, and the most recent renewal card of his license to an authorized representative of the Board.
