In connection with that application, the Board received information that during a period commencing on or about August 2002, the respondent engaged in clinical social work practice at Mental Health Clinic of Passaic, in Passaic, New Jersey notwithstanding that he did not possess a certification or license in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:15BB-4, N.J.A.C. 13:44G-1.3 and N.J.A.C. 13:44G-9.3.


It appearing that the respondent desires to resolve this matter without further proceedings, and the Board finding the entry of the Consent Order to be in the public interest,

IT IS ON THIS DAY OF 2002,
HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT

1. A license to practice social work in the State of New Jersey as a Licensed Social Worker "LSW" shall be issued to Mark H. Staum upon completion of all requirements for licensure.

2. Respondent is hereby assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$250.00 for practicing social work without a license to do so. Said penalty shall be paid by certified check or money order made payable to the State of New Jersey and submitted to the Kay K. McCormack, Executive Director, State Board of Social Work Examiners, PO Box 45033, New Jersey 07101, within fourteen days of the entry of the within Consent Order.
