This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of
Pharmacy upon the receipt of information that respondent was
convicted on August 24, 2001 of the crime of endangering the
welfare of a child. A Provisional Order of Discipline was filed on
the 29th of October, 2001, calling for the revocation of
respondent's license to practice based upon the conviction of a
crime of moral turpitude.

Respondent, having submitted a detailed evaluation by a Board
approved psychotherapist, and the Board, having considered the
results and recommendations set forth in the psychotherapist's
reports, has determined that the following conditions for

respondent's continued licensure are adequately protective of the public.

Accordingly, it is on this 8th day of January 2003,
Ordered and Agreed that:

1. The license of Frank Duncan Kolondra shall be placed on probation for one year from the date of entry of this Order, subject to the following conditions:

a. Respondent shall commence psychotherapy with a Board approved psychotherapist and continue in treatment one time per week. Further, he shall ensure that the psychotherapist submits monthly reports to the Board summarizing respondent's participation and progress in therapy.


b. After six (6) months of weekly psychotherapy, respondent may appear before the Board to request modification of the number of sessions of therapy set forth in (a) above.
