THIS MATTER was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners (hereinafter the "Board") upon receipt of a petition from Pritpaul Singh, M.D., (hereinafter the "Respondent") seeking restoration of his license to **practice** medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey, which was suspended in an Order filed by the Board on March 9, 1995. The Order provided for a five year suspension of Respondent's license; of which three years were to be served as an active suspension, the commencement of treatment with a psychiatrist or psychotherapist with progress reports to the Board, the successful completion of the Probe ethics course, payment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$5,000.00, and Respondent's

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appearance before a Committee of the Board to demonstrate his fitness and competency to practice medicine to the Board's satisfaction.

In April 2001, Respondent, through his counsel Thomas B. Reynolds, Esq., petitioned the Board for reinstatement of his New Jersey medical license. On November 14, 2001, Respondent **appeared** before a Preliminary Evaluation Committee of the Board and testified concerning his compliance with the terms and conditions embodied in the Board's Order of March 9, 1995. Following the respondent's appearance, the Board determined that **the** Respondent should undergo a focused practice evaluation by the Colorado Personalized Education for Physicians' Program (CPEP) to determine his fitness and competency to resume the practice of medicine. Thereafter, the Respondent submitted to the Board an Assessment Report prepared by CPEP and supporting documentation demonstrating his compliance with CPEP's recommendations.

Upon review of available information, the Board is satisfied that Respondent has complied with the terms of the Order of March 9, 1995 as well as CPEP's recommendations for reinstatement of licensure. The Board finding the within disposition is adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare, for the reasons expressed herein and other good cause having been shown,

IT IS, therefore, on this 23 day of April, 2003,

ORDERED THAT:

1. The license of Respondent Pritpaul Singh, M.D., to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey is hereby reinstated.

2. The Respondent shall, within the six (6) months following entry of this Order, take and successfully complete a communication course approved in advance by the Board. **Successful** completion means that all sessions **were** attended, all assignments were properly and appropriately **completed**, and a passing grade was achieved which was unconditional and without reservations.

3. Respondent shall establish a relationship with a preceptor and meet regularly with him/her to ensure integration into practice and application of Respondent's medical knowledge.
