

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE
(Summary Proceeding)

This matter having been opened to the Court on an application brought by the Director of the New Jersey State Division of Consumer Affairs and the State Board of Social Work Examiners, by Peter Harvey, Acting Attorney General of New Jersey, counsel for plaintiffs, Susan C. Berger, Deputy Attorney General appearing,

pursuant to N.J.S.A 45:1-18, 45:1-23, 56:8-8 and R. 4:52-1 and the Court having read the papers submitted, and it appearing that defendant Dorothy M. Neddermeyer has engaged in the unlicensed or uncertified practice of social work and in the use of deception, false promise or false pretense,

IT IS on this 5TH day of May 2003;
ORDERED:

1. Defendant Dorothy M. Neddermeyer shall show cause on the 10th day of June, 2003, at 4:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard, before the Honorable KENNETH S. LEVY, J.S.C. at the Chancery Division, Superior Court, Wilentz Justice Complex located at 212 Washington Street, Newark, New Jersey why an Order on that date should not be entered:

(a) Permanently enjoining defendant Dorothy M. Neddermeyer from engaging in or offering to engage in any activity constituting the unlicensed or uncertified practice of social work in the State of New Jersey and from using the abbreviations "SW," "LCSW," "LSW," "CSW," "SWT," or similar abbreviations until licensed or certified to do so;

(b) Permanently enjoining defendant Dorothy M. Neddermeyer from offering or engaging in any unconscionable commercial practice, deception, fraud, false pretense, false promise or misrepresentation by engaging in or offering to engage in any

activity within the practice of social work in the State of New Jersey and from using the abbreviations "SW," "LCSW," "LSW," "CSW," "SWT," or similar abbreviations unless and until licensed or certified to do so;

(c) Awarding restoration of moneys pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-23 and N.J.S.A. 56:8-13 to clients for unlawfully engagin in counseling and/or therapy services;

(d) Imposing civil penalties and costs pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-23 and 25, as amended, and N.J.S.A. 56:8-11 and 13;


(e) Imposing costs and attorneys' fees pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-25 and N.J.S.A. 56:8-19.

2. Pending the return date set forth herein and until further order of the Court, defendant Dorothy M. Neddermeyer shall be and hereby is temporarily enjoined and restrained from holding herself out as a social worker, counselor and/or therapist, from offering or engaging in the practice of social work in any place in the State of New Jersey and from using abbreviations "SW," "LCSW," "LSW," "CSW," "SWT," or similar abbreviations.

3. Copies of the Order to Show Cause, Verified Complaint and Brief shall be served on the defendant Dorothy M. Neddermeyer no later than **twelve (12)** days before the return date of the Order to Show Cause, by serving the defendant personally or by leaving a copy of the papers at the premises located at 311 Lenox Avenue, South Orange, New Jersey 07079. Said personal service may be made

-r - representative of the Office of the Attorney General pursuant to R. 4:52-1.

4. Defendant Dorothy M. Neddermeyer shall have leave to move for modification or dissolution of the temporary restraints contained herein upon two days' written notice to the Court and all parties. Defendant shall file with the Court and serve upon Deputy Attorney General Susan C. Berger at the Division of Law, 5th Floor, 124 Halsey Street, Newark, New Jersey 07101, an answer to the complaint and any answering affidavits and brief no later than **five (5)** days prior to the return date established herein, and if she fails to do so, judgment by default may be rendered against her.
