SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

On April 10, 2003, the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners (the "Board") filed a Consent Order in the matter of Adam M. Meyers, D.O., pursuant to which we then ordered the suspension of Dr. Meyers' New Jersey license for a period of three years, the first six months of which were to be served as a period of active suspension and the remainder of which were to be stayed and served as a period of probation, provided that respondent complied with all terms and conditions of the Consent Order. That Order further required that respondent was to, during the period of active suspension (which period commenced on May 1, 2003), attend and successfully complete courses acceptable to the Board in the prescribing of controlled dangerous substances and in record-keeping, and to attend and successfully complete a course or program of not less than forty hours duration in addiction medicine.

Respondent appeared before a Committee of the Board on September 24, 2003, and then testified and presented documentation detailing the course work which he has completed to comply with the conditions of the April 10, 2003 Order. Respondent was represented at said appearance by Martin J. McGreevy, Esq.

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The Board having considered the testimony offered by respondent and having reviewed documents detailing that respondent has completed the mandated re-education, and being satisfied that respondent has demonstrated that he is presently fit to resume the practice of medicine in New Jersey, subject to the conditions set forth below, and being satisfied that good cause exists for entry of the within Order,

IT IS on this 3rd day of November, 2003:

ORDERED:


1. Respondent Adam M. Meyers may resume the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey on November 2, 2003, subject to the conditions set forth below. Respondent's practice shall be deemed to be practice conducted during a period of probation, which period of probation shall continue through April 30, 2006.
2. Respondent shall, for a period of six months following the entry of this supplemental Order, monthly provide ten office charts to the Board for review by the Medical Director of the Board. In order to comply with this requirement, respondent shall maintain a log listing all patients seen in his practice, provide the Board with said log on the 28th day of each month, and then make available to the Board ten charts which shall be randomly selected by the Board (or provide charts to the Board pursuant to such other method of chart selection which may be directed by the Board). Dr. Meyers shall make himself available to meet with the Medical Director of the Board, at the Board's offices at 140 East Front Street, Trenton, New Jersey, should the

Medical Director, in his sole discretion, deem it appropriate to meet with Dr. Meyers to discuss any issues that the Medical Director may identify during his review of respondent's charts.

3. The Board explicitly reserves the right to modify this Order, by way of supplemental Order, and to impose any additional conditions and/or limitations which the Board may deem appropriate upon any further practice of medicine by respondent during the period of probation, should cause therefore be identified based upon review of respondent's medical records, or in the event respondent fails to comply with all statutes and regulations governing the practice of medicine.
