**CONSENT ORDER**

This matter was presented to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners ("Board") upon receipt of information and complaints by a variety of sources with regard to an entity known as KIDS of Bergen County, Inc. and/or KIDS of North Jersey, Inc. ("KIDS"). KIDS operated from 1984 to 1998 and provided treatment to adolescents who suffered eating disorders, addictive disorders, and conduct disorders resistant to treatment. The patients at "KIDS" were assigned to treatment categorized by

"phases" of physical control of children, ranging from most physically restrictive ("phase one") to least restrictive ("phase five").

Zisalo Wancier, M.D. is the holder of license **number** MA 029298. Dr. Wancier was **employed at** KIDS from July 1992 until December 1997. During his **tenure** he held the title "Medical Director" and was the official signatory for **KIDS** for third party billing purposes. During his tenure, un-licensed individuals handled **the** initial patient screening process and **signed off** on treatment plans **developed** by un-licensed persons without reviewing the **patient's** medical charts. It is also **alleged** that Dr. Wancier's name was used to bill Medicaid and private **insurance companies** for treatments which Dr. Wancier had neither provided nor supervised. Dr. Wancier did not provide or supervise **pre-service** and in-service training for any staff.

Dr. Wancier has considered the above allegations, but has not yet testified before a Committee of *the* Board. The Board having determined that the within disposition is adequately **protective** of the public health, safety and welfare and Dr. Wancier being desirous of avoiding further proceedings herein,

and good **cause** therefore **existing** for the entry of this Order, it is




