**ORDER FOR SURRENDER
OF LICENSE**

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy upon receipt of information that respondent has been arrested on November 13, 2003 in Dover Township and charged with Driving Under the Influence, possession of Oxycodone, marijuana and drug paraphernalia. It appearing that in lieu of a proceeding to suspend respondent's license to practice pharmacy pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-22, respondent, without admitting to any of the

allegations, and waiving her right to any hearing in this matter, has agreed to surrender her original certificate and license renewal pending further order of the Board.

IT IS THEREFORE on this 11 day of Feb, 2004,

ORDERED AND AGREED, pending further order of the Board, that the license of Barbara Ann Pesciotta, R.P. to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey is hereby surrendered, and it is further

ORDERED AND AGREED, pending further order of the Board, respondent shall cease and desist from engaging in the practice of pharmacy including the following: respondent shall not handle, order, inventory, compound, count, fill, refill or dispense any drug; she shall not handle anything requiring a prescription including devices and medications; she shall not handle prescriptions; she shall not advise or consult with patients, and she is prohibited from being present within a prescription filling area of a pharmacy and it is further,

ORDERED AND AGREED, pending further order of the Board, that respondent shall, simultaneous with the execution of the within Order, surrender her original wall certificate, her wallet certificate, and her most recent renewal card of her license to an authorized representative of the Board, and it is further

ORDERED AND AGREED, upon application for reinstatement, respondent shall submit documentation satisfactory to the Board

inclusive of, but not limited to, twice weekly random witnessed urine screens for a minimum of 6 months, and once weekly random witnessed for the remaining six months, complete treatment records of all diagnostic and rehabilitative therapy and an in-depth, current evaluation from Dr. Frederick Rotgers, a Board approved psychologist.
