**ORDER OF
UNRESTRICTED LICENSURE**

This matter was opened to the State Board of Medical Examiners ("Board") upon the petition of Sanford White, M.D. {"Respondent"} to reinstate his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey without restriction.

Pursuant to a Consent Order filed with the Board on October 31, 2002, Respondent agreed to have a chaperone present during all examinations of female patients.

Respondent appeared before a Preliminary Evaluation Committee of the Board of Medical Examiners on October 29, 2003 seeking unrestricted licensure. The doctor's testimony and his submissions, which include documents evidencing significant continuing medical education and letters from his treating psychiatrist and physician and a position

statement from the Physicians' Health Program of the Medical Society of New Jersey ("PHP") all supporting the reinstatement of his license without restriction demonstrate that he has taken all possible steps to address the events which gave rise to the restrictions placed upon his license and to ensure that such conduct does not occur again.

Dr. White testified that although he feels that his mental and physical health is now under control, he still welcomes the support he draws from meetings with the PHP and support groups.

The Board having considered the respondent's testimony and all relevant documentation submitted and finding the within Order adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare.

IT IS on this 9th day of February, 2004

ORDERED that:

The license of Respondent Sanford White, M.D. to practice medicine in the State of New Jersey shall be and is hereby reinstated without restriction effective nunc pro tunc January 1, 2004.
