**CONSENT ORDER**

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Accountancy by receipt of information that respondent has entered a plea of guilty on November 7, 2003 to a one count misdemeanor Information charging him with failure to file an income tax return with the Internal Revenue Service for the year 2000, in violation of 26 U.S.C. § 7203.

Respondent wishing to voluntarily surrender his license to practice accountancy and acknowledging that the above described conduct constitutes an offense relating adversely to the practice of accountancy regulated by the Board contrary to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(f) and the parties having agreed and consented to the resolution of this matter without the necessity of formal administrative proceedings available to the Board, and respondent understanding the terms and impact of the within Order, and it therefore appearing that due cause exists for the entry of the within Order,

IT IS ON THIS 6th DAY OF April, 2004,

**ORDERED:**

1. That respondent shall have leave to surrender at the Office of the State Board of Accountancy, 124 Halsey Street, Newark, New Jersey, his license to practice as a certified public accountant in the State of New Jersey, both the original certificate and the most current renewal. Such surrender shall be made contemporaneously with the entry of the within Order and shall be with prejudice to seeking the reinstatement thereof for one (1) year from the entry of the within Order.

2. That upon the surrender of his license to practice as a certified public accountant, respondent shall cease and desist from the practice of accountancy regulated by the Board in N.J.S.A. § 45:2B-1, *et. seq.* in the State of New Jersey and shall not hold himself out as a certified public accountant of this State.

3. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of \$2,500.00 and costs of \$500.00 to the New Jersey State Board of Accountancy contemporaneously with the surrender of his license.
