CONSENT ORDER

TO OWN AND OPERATE A PHARMACY :
IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY :

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy on the application of *ABDUL & BORGES, INC.* d/b/a MLK Pharmacy, 173 MLK Drive, Jersey City, New Jersey 07305 to operate a pharmacy in this State. The pharmacy has not been inspected nor has the application for transfer of ownership been approved by the Board of Pharmacy.

Respondent *ABDUL & BORGES, INC.* who has made application to the Board of Pharmacy for a new permit has agreed to the following conditions in operating the store to ensure lawful compliance with all laws governing the practice of pharmacy, both federal and State.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this *12th* day of *May*, 2004,

ORDERED AND AGREED that:

1. MLK Pharmacy and Paresh Ghandi shall not permit any former employee, independent contractor or equity holders of the following pharmacies: "L & S Pharmacy," "Clinton-Bergen Pharmacy," ^{MLK,} "Crast Drugs," "Ampere Pharmacy," "Ironia," "Quickscrip Pharmacy," ^(P) "Billstra Pharmacy," "Rawal Pharmacy," "Family Pharmacy" and "Bayway Pharmacy" to engage in any operation of MLK Pharmacy, including but not limited to, advertising and/or marketing, purchasing, managing, or conducting any business with insurers or third party payors on behalf of the pharmacy, on or off the permitted premises.

2. Respondent shall not transfer the permit to operate nor any percentage of the ownership through any transaction, without the prior, express approval of the Board. Should respondent violate any of the terms of the within Order, the Board may on short notice, hold proceedings to actively suspend the permit.
