This matter was presented to the New Jersey State Board of Chiropractic Examiners ("Board") upon receipt of an investigative report from the Enforcement Bureau, Division of Consumer Affairs. Based upon its review of the Report, it appears to the Board that, in or about 1996 to 2001, Dr. Najemian engaged in professional practices which failed to conform to accepted standards of practice in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21 (b), N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e) and N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(h).

On August 4, 2003, after Dr. Najemian failed to appear at two scheduled investigative inquiries before the Board with regard to the above referenced investigation, the Attorney General filed an Administrative Complaint alleging failure to cooperate with the

Board in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:45C-1.2. Dr. Najemian appeared with counsel at the hearing scheduled for June 24, 2004.

Dr. Najemian has considered the above and has consulted with counsel, but has not yet testified before a Committee of the Board. Dr. Najemian neither admits nor denies any wrongdoing or violation of any rule or law. Dr. Najemian seeks an amicable settlement of this matter. The Board having determined that the within disposition is adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare and Dr. Najemian being desirous of settling this matter without further proceedings herein, and the Board agreeing to settle this matter, and good cause therefore existing for the entry of this Order, it is

ON THIS *24th* DAY OF *JUNE*, 2004

HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent George P. Najemian, D.C. is hereby granted leave and agrees to voluntarily surrender his license to practice chiropractic in the State of New Jersey. Said surrender shall be deemed a permanent retirement of license and Respondent will not re-apply for licensure in the State of New Jersey.

2. Respondent shall immediately return his original license and current biennial registration by way of certified mail to: Kevin Earle, Executive Director, Board of Chiropractic Examiners, Post Office Box 45005, 124 Halsey St., Newark, New Jersey 07101.

3. Respondent shall cease and desist from the practice of chiropractic immediately.

4. Respondent shall pay costs in the amount of \$28,252.15. \$2,500.00 shall be paid within 15 days after the entry of this order. The remaining amount shall be paid at the Court Rule rate of 2% annual interest in consecutive monthly installments of no less than \$750.00 per month, which shall be due by the 15th of each month, commencing ~~30~~ ⁴⁵ days after the entry of this Order. All payments shall be submitted by certified check or money order, made payable to the State of New Jersey, and shall be sent to: Kevin Earle, Executive Director, Board of Chiropractic Examiners, Post Office Box 45005, 124 Halsey St., Newark, New Jersey. A Certificate of Debt shall be duly recorded in the State of New Jersey.

5. Respondent shall provide a copy of this Order to every licensing body by which he is currently licensed to practice and will include a copy of this Order with all applications for licensure which he might submit to any jurisdiction.

6. Respondent shall comply with the "Directives Applicable to Any Chiropractic Board Licensee who is Disciplined or Whose Surrender of Licensure has been Accepted" which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

7. This Order shall constitute a full and final resolution of the Board investigation of violations of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(b), N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e) and N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(h) as well as the

allegations as set forth in the Administrative Complaint filed on August 4, 2003, subject only to enforcement of the terms contained in this Order.


