This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners upon the receipt of information and the application of Christopher Boyhan for licensure to practice athletic training in the State of New Jersey. In connection with that application, the Board received information alleging that he had been practicing athletic training from September 2001 to May 13, 2004 at Boonton High School in the State of New Jersey without having first obtained registration of a license in violation of N.J.S.A.45:8-37.37. Subsequently, Mr. Boyhan received licensure.

The Board having considered the aforesaid information, and the parties being desirous of resolving this matter without the necessity of further formal proceedings; Mr. Boyhan, without acknowledging any violation of the statutes governing the practice of athletic training, but having waived any right to a hearing in this matter; and the Board finding that good cause exists for the entry of the within Order;


ORDERED:
