This matter was opened to the Court, by Plaintiffs, Peter Harvey, Attorney General of New Jersey, the New Jersey Division of Consumer Affairs, the State Board of Medical Examiners and the Athletic Training Advisory Committee by the filing of a Complaint. The Complaint alleged that Christine Champi who is

not registered with the Athletic Training Advisory Committee permitted her employer to represent that she was an Athletic Trainer.

The parties having agreed to the entry of this Consent Order and the Court having reviewed all the documents submitted and good cause existing for the entry of the within order;

IT IS on this 19th day of August, 2004

ORDERED:

1. Defendant Christine Champi is permanently restrained and enjoined from engaging in or holding herself out as engaging in or permitting her employer to represent her as engaging in the practice of athletic training, including but not limited to using the title or designation athletic trainer, "AT," or any other title denoting registration pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:9-37.35 et seq., the use of modalities, taping of injured athletes, reconditioning of injured athletes until released from a physician's care, evaluating or assessing injured athletes beyond first aid or triaging injuries, and/or any activities listed as athletic training responsibilities in N.J.A.C. 13:35-10.6(c) unless and until she is duly authorized by the Board of Medical Examiners and the Athletic Training Advisory Committee to do so.

2. Defendant Christine Champi is permanently restrained and enjoined from engaging in any unconscionable commercial practice, fraud, deception, false promise, false pretense or misrepresentation including but not limited to falsely representing herself as an athletic trainer, permitting her

employer to represent her as an athletic trainer and/or using any other title or designation implying she is authorized to practice athletic training, use modalities, tape injured athletes, recondition injured athletes prior to release from a physician's care, evaluate or assess injured athletes beyond first aid or triage of injuries, and/or any activities listed as athletic training responsibilities in N.J.A.C. 13:35-10.6c, in violation of the Consumer Fraud Act.


3. Defendant shall pay civil penalties in the amount of \$2,000.00 to the State of New Jersey by certified check or money order payable to the Treasurer, State of New Jersey which shall be mailed or delivered to Susan C. Berger, Deputy Attorney General, Department of Law and Public Safety, 124 Halsey Street, P.O. Box 45029, Newark, New Jersey 07101 upon the signing of this Consent Order.

4. In the event, defendant requests a payment plan, upon the signing of this Consent Order, defendant shall make a payment of \$500.00 to the State of New Jersey by certified check or money order payable to the Treasurer, State of New Jersey which shall be mailed or delivered to Susan C. Berger, Deputy Attorney General, Department of Law and Public Safety, 124 Halsey Street, P.O. Box 45029, Newark, New Jersey 07101. The remainder of the civil penalties shall be paid monthly in the amount of \$100.00 per month by certified check or money order payable to the Treasurer, State of New Jersey which shall be mailed or delivered to Susan C. Berger, Deputy Attorney General, Department of Law

and Public Safety, 124 Halsey Street, P.O. Box 45029, Newark, New Jersey 07101 on or before the 1st of the month, beginning on September 1, 2004 until completion of the full payment of \$2,000.00 on or before November 1, 2006. If the defendant fails to make any payment by the 10th of the month in which it is due or if any payment is rejected for insufficient funds or any other reason, the full payment shall immediately become due and owing with interest at the post judgment rate from the date of the filing of the Consent Order.
