

will be out-of-state from April 5 to April 11, 2005, inclusive. Respondent, consequently, seeks an adjournment of the return date of the Order to Show Cause until the next regular meeting of the Board, scheduled for April 20, 2005, and has agreed to voluntarily surrender his license to practice dentistry under the terms and conditions set forth below. The Board, finding the within disposition to be adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare, it is, therefore:

ORDERED AND AGREED, on this 6th day of April, 2005, that:

1. The return date of the Order to Show Cause filed in the above-captioned matter be, and it hereby is, adjourned until April 20, 2005;
2. Respondent, Anthony Joseph Emmocida, D.M.D., shall immediately surrender his license to practice dentistry in the State of New Jersey until further Order of the Board or for a period of thirty (30) days, beginning from the date of this Interim Consent Order, whichever shall occur first. Respondent acknowledges that any order issued by the Board, subsequent to this Interim Consent Order, may be adverse to Respondent's interests. If a subsequent adverse Order is issued by the Board, a component of which order requires Respondent's license to be suspended, Respondent will be credited with any time contemplated by this Interim Consent Order during which his license had actually been surrendered;
3. Respondent shall cause to be provided an evaluation and/or treatment materials, whether based on Respondent's April 5 - April 11, 2005 evaluation, or any subsequent evaluation and/or treatment, by, on behalf of or in conjunction with the Program, or any other subsequent substance abuse program in which Respondent participates, to Alan R. Niedz, D.A.G., Division of Law, 124 Halsey Street, P.O. Box 45029, Newark, New Jersey 07101, for submission to the Board. Such evaluation shall be provided on or before April 15, 2005.

4. Respondent shall make available forthwith, to the deputy attorney general named in the previous paragraph, any and all materials generated in connection with any program for evaluation or for treatment in which Respondent participated as a result of his December 1, 2004 guilty plea in Commonwealth of Pennsylvania v. Anthony Joseph Ermocida, Case Number 2004-6621, which materials were provided to Respondent or his current or any previous attorney.


