TO PRACTICE MEDICINE AND SURGERY  
IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY

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This **mattes was** opened to the New **Jersey State** Board of Medical Examiners (Board) upon **receipt** of a Judgment in a criminal case. entered on or about January 11, 2005 by the United **States** District Court Eastern District of Pennsylvania, Criminal Division, in which Respondent pleaded guilty as to Count 1 of the Information for Causing the Misbranding of Drugs in violation of Title 21, United States Code. Section 331(k), 333(a)(1). **As a** result of the foregoing Respondent **was** sentenced to thirty-six (**36**) months probation. home confinement with electronic monitoring for a period of five (5) months, one thousand (1,000) hours of community service, **and a** thirty-thousand dollar (\$30,000.00) fine.

The Board has been advised that an action is pending by the Pennsylvania Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs' **office** (the Pennsylvania Board **is** responsible for the licensing of physicians in Pennsylvania ) with regard to the federal criminal **plea** referenced **above**.

**As** Respondent's medical practice is located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and as Respondent, has represented **to** the Board that at the present **time** he **is** not engaged in **the** practice of medicine in the State of New Jersey. the Board and Respondent **seek** to resolve this matter on an **interim** basis without resort to further proceedings, **and** recognizing that Respondent agrees not to practice medicine in New Jersey **until** further **order** of **this** Board. The Board reserving **the** right to take **further** action, and finding the within Order **is** sufficiently protective of the public interest and for good cause shown,

IT IS ON THIS 15th DAY OF April ,2005, ORDERED THAT:

1. Effective immediately and until further order of the Board. Respondent voluntarily agrees to, and shall cease and desist the practice of medicine in the **State** of New Jersey until the resolution of proceedings by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Bureau of **Professional** and Occupational Affairs' office which specifically address Respondent's federal criminal plea for Causing the Misbranding of Drugs.

2. At such time as Respondent receives notice of the resolution by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Bureau of Professional *and* **Occupational** Affairs' office regarding Respondent's federal criminal plea referenced above, Respondent shall immediately provide **to** the Board copies of **all** orders and other relevant documents filed pertaining to his federal criminal conviction of January 11.2005.

3. The Board reserves the right to require Respondent to **appear** before **a** Committee of the Board to demonstrate **full** satisfaction of this Order.

4. The Board may at any time hereafter exercise any authority conferred by **law** including but

not limited to the institution of formal disciplinary proceedings regarding the federal criminal plea referenced above, or any action by the authorities of another state regarding Respondent's license to practice medicine.




