ORDER

TO PRACTICE MEDICINE AND SURGERY :
IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY :

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners ("the Board") based upon action taken in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts against the medical license of Respondent, Burton A. Waisbren, M.D., License No. MA46980.

On June 9, 1993, the Board entered a Consent Agreement ordering Respondent to refrain from the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey until such time as he appeared before the Board and received the Board's approval to commence practice in New Jersey. Pursuant to the Consent Order, Respondent

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was ordered to provide the Board with a progress report from his psychotherapist prior to *his* appearance before the Board and to demonstrate compliance with the terms and conditions of the Massachusetts Board of Registration in Medicine agreement. The Board's action was taken pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(g), in that, Respondent had his authority to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery suspended by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

On December 22, 2004, Respondent appeared before a Preliminary Evaluation Committee ("Committee") of the Board and requested the Board's approval to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey at the Deborah Heart and Lung Center, Browns Mills, New Jersey. On January 12, 2005, the Board reviewed the Committee's recommendation to grant Respondent's request and determined that Respondent satisfied the terms of the Consent Order issued on June 9, 1993. The Board being satisfied with the information provided by the treating psychotherapist in accord with the Consent Order issued on June 9, 1993, and the Board being satisfied that Respondent's practice is consistent with the health, safety and welfare of the public:

IT IS on this 22ND day of APRIL, 2005, ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent has complied with the terms and conditions of the Consent Order executed by the Board on June 9, 1993, and may

resume the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey.
