Offer of Settlement In Lieu of Filing a Formal Disciplinary Complaint

Dear Mr. Zambetti:

This letter is to advise you that the New Jersey State Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors (hereinafter the "Board") has had an opportunity to review information concerning your professional conduct, (hereinafter "you") with regard to a complaint filed against you by the complainant, Donna Rosamilia.

Upon review of all available information, the Board has preliminarily found that probable cause exists to support a finding that you are in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:8-56 in that your company did not have a Certificate of Authorization. However, the Board notes that you immediately applied for and obtained a Certificate of Authorization upon receiving the complaint. As to the allegations set forth by the complainant, the Board has determined that there is insufficient cause for further action.

As a result of the foregoing, the Board has preliminarily determined that the above violation is sufficient to warrant the initiation of formal proceedings against you. Notwithstanding that decision, the Board has determined that it will first offer you an opportunity to settle this matter in an attempt to avoid the initiation of more formal proceedings if you consent to the payment of a civil penalty totaling \$500.00 to be paid immediately upon your signing of the acknowledgment at the bottom of this letter in connection with your violation of N.J.S.A. 45:8-56.


In an effort to resolve this matter amicably, the Board offers to settle on the terms stated above. If you are willing to resolve this matter on the offered settlement terms, you may do so by signing the acknowledgment at the bottom of this letter and returning it to the Board office within 15 days. In such event, this letter shall be a matter of public record.

In the event you are unwilling to settle this matter on the offered terms, it will be referred to the Attorney General's office for the initiation of formal proceedings. In such event, you will be afforded an opportunity to defend against the alleged violations. You are advised, however, that in the event formal charges are filed, you may be assessed civil penalties in an amount greater than that herein offered in settlement should any charges against you be sustained. Additionally, the Board may, if the facts herein or any additional facts are found to so warrant, enter an order requiring you to reimburse certain monies and/or requiring you to pay costs incurred by the Board. Should you have any questions concerning this letter or the settlement offer herein, I suggest that you contact Deputy Attorney General Michelle Albertson, who may be reached at (973) 648-2975.

If you elect to settle this matter, you should sign the acknowledgment at the bottom of this letter and return it to the Board within fifteen (15) days following your receipt of this letter. In the event that the Board receives no response from you within fifteen (15) days, the Board's settlement offer shall be considered withdrawn and the matter will be referred to the Attorney General's Office for the initiation of formal proceedings.
