

issued for a legitimate medical purpose pursuant to a valid patient-physician relationship.

3. The following disciplinary action was ordered; revocation of the DEA permit of EZRX, LLC and the denial of any pending applications for renewal of such registration.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The above disciplinary action by a federal agency provides grounds for the revocation of the permit to operate a pharmacy in the State of New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(g) in that respondent's authority to engage in the dispensing of controlled dangerous substances has been revoked by the Drug Enforcement Administration.

Based on the foregoing findings and conclusions, a Provisional Order of Discipline suspending respondent's permit to operate a pharmacy in the State of New Jersey was entered on April 12, 2005 and a copy was forwarded to respondent at the last known address on file with the board. The Provisional Order was subject to finalization by the Board at 5:00 p.m. on the 30th business day following entry unless respondent requested a modification or dismissal of the stated Findings of Fact or Conclusions of Law by submitting a written request for modification or dismissal setting forth in writing any and all reasons why said findings and conclusions should be modified or dismissed and submitting any and all documents or other written evidence supporting respondent's request for consideration and reasons therefor.

Although the Provisional Order sent by means of certified mail was returned as not claimed, the regular mail sent to EZRX, P.O. Box 293173, Davie Florida 33329 was not returned. Because the Order was forwarded to respondent's address of record, the Board deems service to have been effected. Accordingly it is determined that further proceedings are not necessary and the the Provisional Order should be made final.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 15th day of June, 2005,
ORDERED that:

1. Respondent's permit to operate a pharmacy in the State of New Jersey be and hereby is revoked.
