

This matter was opened before the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy upon receipt of information that Respondent had engaged in improper and unauthorized dispensing practices, to wit, diverting Tylenol with Codeine No. 3, a Schedule III Controlled Dangerous Substance, from his employer, Eckerd Drugs.

It appearing that in lieu of a proceeding to temporarily suspend Respondent's license to practice pharmacy pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-22, and Respondent, having successfully completed a rehabilitative out-patient treatment program, voluntarily agrees to refrain from further practice of pharmacy effective August 1, 2005, and to surrender his original certificate, license renewal card,

and wallet card to the Office of the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy, 124 Halsey Street, Newark, New Jersey 07101, and the Board finding the within disposition adequately protective of the safety, health and welfare of the public.

IT IS THEREFORE, ON THIS 13<sup>th</sup> DAY OF July, 2005,

ORDERED and agreed that the license of Arthur L. Silk to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey is surrendered to be considered a suspension effective August 1, 2005, with prejudice such that there is no right to request reinstatement of license, and it is further

ORDERED and agreed that effective August 1, 2005 Respondent shall cease and desist from engaging in the practice of pharmacy including the following: Respondent shall not handle, order inventory, compound, count, fill, refill or dispense any drug; he shall not handle anything requiring a prescription including devices and medications; he shall not handle prescriptions; he shall not advise or consult with patients, and he is prohibited from being present within a prescription filing area of a pharmacy, and it is further


ORDERED and agreed that Respondent shall by execution of the within Order surrender his original wall certificate, his wallet card, and his most recent renewal card of his license to an authorized representative of the Board of Pharmacy, and it is further

ORDERED and agreed that nothing herein provided shall preclude the Board from affirmatively initiating any action which may be authorized by law, at such time as the Board may deem it appropriate to initiate such action.
