**FINAL ORDER
OF DISCIPLINE**

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy upon receipt of information which the Board has reviewed and on which the following findings of fact and conclusions of law are made.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is a pharmacist in the State of New Jersey and had been a licensee at all times relevant hereto. His license expired April 30, 2005.

2. On June 30, 2004 respondent was the subject of a Judgment filed in the Supreme Court of the State of New York, Queens County. Specifically, respondent was convicted of Grand Larceny 3rd Degree in violation of PL 155.35

3. Respondent was sentenced to a six (6) month imprisonment, a five (5) year probationary term and ordered to make restitution of \$811,000.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The above judgment provides grounds for the suspension of his license to practice pharmacy in New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(f) in that the conviction is one of moral turpitude and/or reflects adversely on the practice of pharmacy.

Based on the foregoing findings and conclusions, a Provisional Order of Discipline suspending respondent's license to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey was entered on July 20, 2005 and a copy was forwarded to respondent's last known address by means of both regular and certified mail. The Provisional Order was subject to finalization by the Board at 5:00 p.m. on the 30th business day following entry unless respondent requested a modification or dismissal of the stated Findings of Fact or Conclusions of Law by submitting a written request for modification or dismissal setting forth in writing any and all reasons why said findings and conclusions should be modified or dismissed and submitting any and all documents or other written evidence supporting respondent's request for consideration and reasons therefor.

Although the record reflects that the Provisional Order was served upon respondent, no response has been received to date. Accordingly the Board considered the matter, determined that

further proceedings were not necessary and Provisional Order should be made final.

IT IS THEREFORE on this 19th day of October, 2005,

ORDERED that:

1. Respondent's license to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey be and hereby is revoked.

2. Prior to resuming active practice in New Jersey respondent shall be required to appear before the Board (or a committee thereof) to demonstrate his fitness to do so, and any practice in this State prior to said appearance shall constitute grounds for a charge of unlicensed practice. In addition, the board reserves the right to place restrictions on respondent's practice should his license be reinstated.

3. Pending further order of the Board, respondent shall cease and desist from engaging in the practice of pharmacy, including the following: respondent shall not handle, order, inventory, compound, count, fill, refill or dispense any drug; shall not handle anything requiring a prescription including devices and medications; he shall not handle prescriptions; he shall not advise or consult with any patient, and he is prohibited from being present within a prescription filling area of any pharmacy.

4. Respondent shall by execution of the within Order surrender his original wall certificate, his wallet certificate,

and his most recent renewal cared of his license to an authorized representative of the Board.
