**FINAL CONSENT ORDER**

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners upon the filing of an Order to Show Cause, Notice of Hearing and Verified Complaint on May 2, 2005 by the Attorney General, Peter C. Harvey, by Megan Matthews, Deputy Attorney General. The Complaint alleged that assessments of Respondent's general medical skills and particular anesthesiology skill set indicate that Respondent lacks the most basic medical knowledge and skill to safely practice either general medicine or anesthesiology. Respondent filed an Answer on July 12, 2005 in which he denied the majority of the allegations. A hearing was held on July 13, 2005 at which time the Board considered expert testimony on behalf of the Attorney General and the Respondent and at which time the Respondent also testified. In an Order of the Board filed on August 10, 2005, the Board ultimately concluded that if Respondent were permitted to practice with an unlimited license he would surely present a clear and imminent danger to the public but that he had thus far

demonstrated appropriate judgment by limiting his practice so that he utilizes his medical license but is not providing direct patient care. The Board ordered that Respondent temporarily limit his practice of medicine solely to the conducting of Independent Medical Examinations for third parties in the area of musculoskeletal cases and the rendering of reports based on those examinations. The Board further ordered that Respondent be prohibited from prescribing any medications and that he complete Board approved continuing medical education. A hearing date has not yet been scheduled for the final resolution of this matter.

The parties, having agreed to the resolution of this matter without further formal proceedings, and Respondent having agreed and given his voluntary consent to the within Order, and the Board finding the within disposition is adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare, and other good cause having been shown,

IT IS on this 11 day of November, 2005

ORDERED THAT

1. Respondent shall permanently limit his practice of medicine in the State of New Jersey solely to the conducting of Independent Medical Examinations on behalf of third parties and with regard to patients demonstrating musculoskeletal symptomology; and the rendering of reports based on those examinations.
2. Respondent shall be permanently prohibited from prescribing any medications including prescription legend drugs and controlled substances.
3. Respondent shall immediately upon receipt of a filed copy of this Order advise the DEA of this Order.
4. Respondent shall pay the costs of investigation conducted by the Enforcement Bureau of the Division of Consumer Affairs of this matter in the amount of \$1125.59, attorney's fees in the


amount of \$11,205.00, costs of transcripts in the amount of \$3305.76 and the costs of expert review in the amount of \$300 for a total of \$15,936.35. Payments shall be made in six equal monthly installments of \$2656.06 due on or before the <sup>fifteenth</sup>~~first~~ of each month beginning December <sup>15</sup>~~1~~, 2005. *RDN*

Payment shall be made by check or money order made payable to the New Jersey Board of Medical Examiners and mailed to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners, 140 E. Front Street, P.O. Box 183, Trenton, New Jersey 08625-0183.

5. Respondent shall comply with the continuing medical education requirements as outlined in the Order of Temporary Restriction of License filed August 10, 2005.


6. The allegations set forth in the Verified Complaint of May 2, 2005 are fully resolved and adjudicated by entry of this Consent Order.


