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This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners upon the filing of a Provisional Order of Discipline on October 26, 2005, by Peter C. Harvey, Attorney General of New Jersey, by Mileidy Perez, Deputy Attorney General, seeking to suspend the license of Respondent, Justin S. Psaila, M.D., to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(f), (g) and N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.1(b). The Provisional Order of Discipline was based on information that on or about February 2, 2005, in the County Court of Rockland in New City, New York, Respondent was found guilty of two (2) counts of Grand larceny in the third degree, a class D felony, in violation

of §155.35 of the Penal Law of the State of New York. On or about May 17, 2005, Respondent was sentenced to three (3) years conditional discharge and ordered to pay \$436,628.35 in restitution. On or about July 14, 2005, the State of New York, Department of Health, State Board of Professional Medical Conduct ("New York Board") filed a Statement of Charges against Respondent based on Respondent's criminal conviction and charging Respondent with a violation of New York Education Law §6530(9)(a)(i) by having been convicted of committing an act constituting a crime under New York State law. On or about July 19, 2005, the New York Board issued an Order adopting the terms of the Surrender Agreement executed by Respondent on July 7, 2005, wherein Respondent agreed to surrender his license as a physician in the State of New York. By entry of the Order Respondent's name was removed from the roster of physicians in the State of New York.

The parties being desirous of resolving this matter and the Board finding the within Order to be adequately protective of the public interest and for good cause shown,

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 7<sup>TH</sup> day of FEBRUARY, 2006,

ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey shall be and is hereby voluntarily surrendered with prejudice, precluding Respondent from seeking

reinstatement of his license in this State at any time in the future.

2. Respondent shall cease and desist from any practice of medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey immediately upon entry of this Order and shall surrender his original license certificate within thirty (30) days of the entry of this Order.
