This matter was originally opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners upon receipt of information that the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Board of Registration in Medicine ("Massachusetts Board") issued an Order on January 19, 2005 accepting the resignation of respondent's license to practice medicine. Respondent's resignation came during an investigation by the Massachusetts Board into allegations that he had engaged in sexual relations with a patient. In paragraph four (4) of respondent's notarized Resignation statement dated January 19,

2005, respondent states that he is not currently licensed to practice medicine in any other state or he will resign any other licenses contemporaneously with the resignation of his Massachusetts medical license. Respondent further states that he will make no attempt to gain licensure elsewhere at any time. Respondent was granted a license to practice medicine in New Jersey on February 18, 1997, placed that license in an inactive status on June 30, 1997 and has been ineligible to practice medicine in New Jersey since June 30, 1997. Consistent with respondent's statement that he will resign any other licenses contemporaneously with the resignation of his Massachusetts license, Respondent has agreed to voluntarily surrender his license to practice medicine in New Jersey with prejudice and in accordance with the terms of this Order. The Board finding the within disposition to be adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare,

IT IS THEREFORE on this 7TH day of FEBRUARY , 2006,

ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent, Wagdy F. Aziz, M.D., is hereby granted leave and shall immediately surrender his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey with prejudice. Respondent shall not apply for reinstatement of his license.

2. Respondent shall return his original New Jersey license to William Roeder, Executive Director, New Jersey State

Board of Medical Examiners, P. O. Box 183, Trenton, New Jersey
08625-0183, contemporaneously with his signing of this Order.
