TO PRACTICE PHARMACY IN THE
STATE OF NEW JERSEY

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Pharmacy after the receipt of a consumer complaint alleging that a medication error had been made by Doris Seavey. Upon further investigation the Board of Pharmacy determined that respondent had continued to work as a pharmacist at Eckerd's Pharmacy, Millville, New Jersey from April 30, 2001 to November 10, 2005 after her license to practice had expired as a result of her failure to renew in April of 2001. It appearing that in lieu of a proceeding to revoke respondent's right to reinstate her license to practice pharmacy pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21, 45:1-23 and 45:1-21(C),

respondent waiving her right to any hearing in this matter, has agreed to surrender her right to reinstate her license to be deemed a revocation with prejudice to reinstatement for three (3) years from the date of entry of this Order; and for other good cause shown;

IT IS THEREFORE on this 22nd day of February, 2006,

ORDERED AND AGREED:

The license of ~~Barbara~~ Doris Seavey, R.P. to practice pharmacy in the State of New Jersey is hereby surrendered to be deemed a revocation, with prejudice to any reapplication prior to three (3) years from the date of entry of this Order; and it is further,

ORDERED AND AGREED:

Respondent shall cease and desist from engaging in the practice of pharmacy including the following: respondent shall not handle, order, inventory, compound, count, fill, refill or dispense any drug; she shall not handle anything requiring a prescription including devices and medications; she shall not handle prescriptions; she shall not advise or consult with patients, and she is prohibited from being present within a prescription filling area of a pharmacy and it is further,

ORDERED AND AGREED:


Respondent shall pay to the Board of Pharmacy a civil penalty of \$10,000.00 for engaging in the unlicensed practice of

pharmacy, and a fine of \$250.00 for committing a medication error. Respondent may request a payment schedule from the Executive Director of the Board within 30 days of the entry of this Order. Should there be no payment schedule in place at that time, all monies will be due and owing immediately and a Certificate of Debt will be filed in Superior Court.


ORDERED AND AGREED:
