

Respondent wishing to voluntarily surrender his license to practice accountancy and acknowledging that the above described conduct constitutes professional misconduct contrary to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e) and the parties having agreed and consented to the resolution of this matter without the necessity of formal administrative proceedings available to the board, and respondent understanding the terms and impact of the within Order, and it therefore appearing that due cause exists for the entry of the within Order;

IT IS THEREFORE on this *24th* day of *March*, 2006,

ORDERED that:


1. The license of respondent to engage in the practice of accountancy in the State of New Jersey is hereby suspended for six (6) months.
2. That respondent shall immediately surrender to the State Board of Accountancy, 124 Halsey street, Newark, New Jersey, his license to practice accountancy in the State of New Jersey, both the original certificate and the most current renewal.
3. That upon the surrender of his license to practice accounting, respondent shall cease and desist the practice of accounting in the State of New Jersey and shall not hold himself out as a certified public accountant of this State for the duration of the suspension.

4. Respondent shall pay \$200.00 to the Board of Accountancy for the costs of the investigation of this matter to the State within thirty (30) days from the date of the filing of this Order.

I, BRUCE E. MANTELL, of full age, being duly sworn to law, upon my oath depose and say:

- 1. Eugene Leporiere has signed a Consent Order on March 24, 2006 whereby he has agreed to a six month suspension of his license to engage in the practice of accountancy in the State of New Jersey.
- 2. The Consent Order, at Paragraph 2, states that "The Respondent shall immediately surrender to the State Board of Accountancy, 124 Halsey Street, Newark, New Jersey, his license to practice accountancy in the State of New Jersey, both the original certificate and the most current renewal".
- 3. Pursuant to a number of telephone conferences with Marianne W. Greenwald, Deputy Attorney General, it has been agreed that Mr. Leporiere will not surrender his CPA Certificate to the New Jersey State Board of Accountancy, but, rather, has surrendered both his original Certificate and the most recent renewal to Mantell & Prince, P.C. (M&PPC)
- 4. M&PPC is holding Mr. Leporiere's original Certificate and the most recent renewal in escrow until September 24, 2006, at which time it will be returned to Mr. Leporiere as his six-month suspension to engage in the practice of accountancy in the State of New Jersey will expire.
