This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners (the Board) upon receipt of a complaint alleging that Respondent gave false testimony during a deposition regarding the scope of responsibilities of an assistant surgeon and also alleging that Respondent, who has an inactive New Jersey podiatric medical license, engaged in the unlicensed practice of podiatry when he conducted an examination and ordered x-rays of a patient during the time he served as an expert witness in a malpractice case. The Board reviewed the record of the investigation in this matter including information acquired before a Preliminary

Evaluation Committee attended by Respondent and his counsel, Stephen D. Cuyler, Esq., on September 22, 2004.

The Respondent being desirous of resolving this matter without resort to formal proceedings, and the Board having determined that the following provisions are adequately protective of the public welfare, and for good cause shown,

IT IS, THEREFORE ON THIS 19th DAY OF April, 2006, HEREBY ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. The Respondent, Clark D. Miller, D.P.M., is hereby reprimanded for engaging in the practice of podiatry while on inactive status in that he ordered x-rays in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-7.3.

2. Respondent, Clark D. Miller, D.P.M., shall cease and desist from engaging in professional practice within the State of New Jersey during the period of time his New Jersey podiatric license is on inactive status.

3. Respondent, Clark D. Miller, D.P.M., shall pay the costs of the Board's investigation of this matter in the amount of \$1,300.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45: 1-25(d).

4. Failure to remit any payment required by this Order will result in the filing of a certificate of debt.


5. Failure to comply with any of the terms of this Consent Order may result in further disciplinary action.


