CONSENT ORDER

Defendant, Mark A. Radowitz, D.C., having entered a plea of guilty to the charge of second degree Health Care Claims Fraud, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-4.2, now comes before this court to surrender his license to practice chiropractic to be deemed a revocation, in accordance with the plea agreement.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ON THIS 21 DAY OF April 2006,

ORDERED that Mark A. Radowitz, D.C. shall surrender his license to practice chiropractic in the State of New Jersey to be deemed a revocation, and it is further

ORDERED that defendant shall cease and desist from engaging in the practice of chiropractic, and shall comply with the Directives of the New Jersey Board of Chiropractic Examiners applicable to any Chiropractic Board licensee who is suspended, revoked or whose surrender of licensure has been accepted, which are incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein, whether or not they are attached hereto; and it is further

ORDERED that defendant shall surrender his original wall certificate and the most recent renewal card of his license registration to an authorized representative of the New Jersey State Board of Chiropractic Examiners within ten (10) days hereof, and it is further

ORDERED and acknowledged that nothing herein shall preclude the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners from taking any additional action against the defendant based upon his conviction, or based upon his acts constituting the crime to which he has pleaded guilty, and it is further

ORDERED that a copy of this Consent Order shall be provided to the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners; and may be used against the defendant in any civil or administrative proceeding related to the suspension or revocation of defendant's license to practice chiropractic.
