CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Accountancy upon receipt of information that respondent has held himself out to the public as a certified public accountant in the State of New Jersey without being licensed and, further, failed to register the firm of Zigman and Zigman all in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:2B-62.


ORDERED AND AGREED:

- 1. Respondent shall cease and desist holding himself out to the public as a certified public accountant licensed in the State of New Jersey. He shall not use any stationery, stamps, business cards, taped messages or other representations indicating he is an accountant licensed in New Jersey, nor shall he advertise as a firm of accountants or list himself on his firm letterhead as a certified public accountant. He shall take affirmative steps to register the firm of Zigman and Zigman with the Board office immediately.


2. Respondent shall pay a \$3,500 civil penalty for the unlicensed practice of accountancy and for the failure to register the firm Zigman and Zigman.

3. Respondent specifically agrees and acknowledges that upon any further violation of this Order, the Superior Court of the State of New Jersey may after a summary hearing enter an Order restraining respondent from such violations upon affidavit of the Attorney Genera and without notice to respondent.
