This matter was opened before the Alcohol and Drug Counselor Committee of the New Jersey State Board of Marriage and Family Therapy Examiners (hereinafter "the Committee"), upon review of Mr. Teed's application for licensure as a Licensed Clinical Alcohol and Drug Counselor (LCACD). He is currently licensed by the New Jersey State Board of Social Work Examiners as a Licensed Clinical Social Worker. In his application to the Committee, the applicant revealed that on or about September 10, 1987, he plead guilty in the Superior Court Division, General Court of Justice, Avery County, North Carolina to taking indecent liberties with a minor. He was sentenced to three years probation and required to seek a psychological evaluation, counseling and or treatment and community service. The applicant has submitted documentation that he was cooperative,

compliant, and conscientious in fulfilling his probation responsibilities.

The applicant has submitted documentation that during the course of his application for licensure by the New Jersey State Board of Social Work Examiners, he submitted to a psychological evaluation, completed the process, was granted a social work license and subsequently a clinical social work license. The applicant provided the Committee with a copy of the psychological report. The report included information from his therapists and employers who supported his application for licensure as a social worker provided he limited his practice to adults.

The Committee having reviewed Mr. Teed's application, the psychological evaluation and that Mr. Teed has limited his practice to working with an adult population and has had success in the field; the Committee finding that the following disposition of this matter is adequately protective of the public, and other good cause appearing;

IT IS THEREFORE ON THIS 3rd DAY OF July, 2006

ORDERED:

1. The applicant shall be granted a restricted license to practice clinical alcohol and drug counseling conditioned upon compliance with the terms of this Consent Order and all requirements for licensure as an alcohol and drug counselor.

2. The applicant's practice of alcohol and drug counseling shall be limited to treatment of adults at an adult treatment facility unless and until the Committee issues a subsequent Order.

3. The applicant shall notify the Committee in writing of any changes in or additional places of employment. The written

notification shall be sent to the Executive Director, Alcohol and Drug Counselor Committee, 124 Halsey Street, P.O. Box 45040, Newark, New Jersey 07101 within ten (10) days of commencement of any new or additional position as an alcohol and drug counselor. Additionally, in each position in which the applicant is providing alcohol and drug counseling, the applicant is required to provide his employer with a copy of this Consent Order and cause the employer to acknowledge in writing to the Committee that the employer has received a copy of this Consent Order, and will immediately report any violations of the Order to the Committee in writing.

4. The applicant shall be precluded from engaging in any independent or private practice of alcohol and drug counseling unless and until the Committee issues a subsequent Order.

5. The applicant shall be precluded from supervising any practice of alcohol and drug counseling, including but not limited to the supervision of certified alcohol and drug counselors (CADCs) or counselor interns, unless and until the Committee issues a subsequent written order.

6. The applicant shall obey all of the laws of the State of New Jersey, the United States and their political subdivisions as well as all regulations, rules or laws pertaining to the practice of alcohol and drug counseling in this State or any other State.
