
This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers ("Board") upon receipt of information that Acqua Pure, a heating and plumbing company, abandoned a sewer line replacement job they contracted to perform for consumer A.P. Robert T. Schiff ("respondent") was the bona fide representative for Acqua Pure during the time of the contract.

The facts of this matter appear to be as follows. On July 29, 2005, Acqua Pure agreed to perform a sewer line replacement for A.P.. The estimated and agreed cost of the job was \$2,782.50. The parties agreed that A.P. would pay \$1,590 to Acqua Pure as a deposit for the services and A.P. issued a check in that amount to Acqua Pure on the same day. On August 2, 2006, Acqua Pure requested and received a construction permit from the Township of Teaneck to perform the plumbing


1. Respondent shall be assessed a civil penalty in the aggregate amount of \$500 for committing professional/occupational misconduct, in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e), by abandoning the job he was contracted to perform for consumer A.P. The penalty shall be paid by money order or certified check made payable to the State of New Jersey and delivered to the Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers, 124 Halsey Street, Sixth Floor, Newark, NJ 07101, simultaneously with the signing of this Consent Order. In the event respondent fails to make timely payment, a certificate of debt shall be filed and interest shall accrue at the rate provided by the Rules of Court.

2. A.P. was entitled to restitution from respondent in the amount of \$590. The Board acknowledges that respondent has already provided a check to the Board, made payable to A.P., in the amount of \$590, thereby having already satisfied the amount of restitution due to consumer A.P.
