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This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Professional Counselor Examiners Committee of the New Jersey State Board of Marriage and Family Therapy Examiners ("the Committee") upon receipt of information that on or about July 19, 2006, Christopher Marc Hoyer, L.P.C., ("Respondent") was indicted in the Superior Court of New Jersey, Criminal Division, Atlantic County, and charged with 18 counts of criminal conduct involving a minor. Specifically, the Committee has received information that Respondent has been charged with violating N.J.S.A. 2C:5-1 and

2C:14-3b (Attempted Criminal Sexual Contact); N.J.S.A. 2C:13-6, (Luring, Enticing Child, Attempts); N.J.S.A. 2C:5-1 and 2C:24-4, (Attempted Endangering Welfare of Child); N.J.S.A. 2C:34-3b(2) (Attempted to Knowingly Show Obscene Material); and N.J.S.A. 2C:5-1 & 2C:14-2c (Attempted Sexual Assault).

The Respondent agreeing to be bound by the terms and conditions set forth in this Consent Order and the New Jersey State Professional Counselor Examiners Committee of the New Jersey State Board of Marriage and Family Therapy Examiners having determined that the following provisions are sufficiently protective of the public interest and welfare, and for good cause shown:

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 7<sup>th</sup> day of Sept., 2006,  
ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent shall immediately surrender his license to practice professional counseling in the State of New Jersey and shall immediately cease and desist from advertising, offering to engage in or engaging in the practice of professional counseling.
2. Respondent shall return his current license to practice professional counseling and wall certificate along with this signed Interim Consent Order to Mileidy Perez, Deputy Attorney General, Division of Law, 124 Halsey Street, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, Newark, New Jersey 07101.
3. Respondent may apply for reinstatement of his license to practice professional counseling at such time as the Committee has

concluded an investigative inquiry concerning the above criminal action and determined that Respondent is fit and competent to resume the practice of professional counseling.

4. The investigative inquiry of Respondent by the Committee shall be held in abeyance until such time as the criminal proceedings against Respondent are concluded whether by plea, entry into a Pre-Trial Intervention program or conclusion of a criminal trial.


5. Respondent shall inform the Committee in writing within 20 days after the resolution of the criminal charges, of the disposition the criminal matter and provide copies of such disposition to the Committee.

6. This order is entered without admission of any wrongdoing by Respondent and without prejudice to the ability of Respondent to defend against any disciplinary action filed by the Committee.




