CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners upon receipt of information that on or about November 30, 2005, the New York State Department of Health, State Board for Professional Medical Conduct ("New York Board"), filed a Statement of Charges alleging that Vladimir Margolin, M.D. ("Respondent") committed professional misconduct in his treatment of Patients A, B, C, D, E, F and G, by engaging in fraudulent practice as defined by N.Y. Educ. Law §6530(2), filing a false report or failing to file a report as defined in N.Y. Educ. Law §6530(21), and engaging in conduct evidencing moral unfitness to practice as defined in N.Y. Educ. Law §6530(20). The New York Board also alleged that Respondent, in his treatment of Patients A,

B, C, D, E and F, committed acts of negligence on more than one occasion as defined by N.Y. Educ. Law §6530(3), practiced the profession of medicine with incompetence on more than one occasion as defined by N.Y. Educ. Law §6530(5), performed excessive tests and treatments as defined by N.Y. Educ. Law §6530(35), and failed to maintain a record for each patient which accurately reflects the care and treatment of the patient as defined by N.Y. Educ. Law §6530(32).

On or about April 3, 2006, the New York Board entered a Consent Order adopting the terms of the Consent Agreement executed by Respondent, suspending Respondent for a period of 24 months with said suspension stayed, and placing Respondent on probation for a period of 36 months. Pursuant to the Consent Agreement, Respondent acknowledged that he could not successfully defend against at least one of the charges in the Statement of Charges and agreed to enter into the Consent Agreement in full satisfaction of the charges against him. By entry of the Consent Agreement and Order, Respondent must complete 140 hours of continuing medical education in the Medical Knowledge Self-Assessment Program administered by the American College of Physicians and must pay a fine in the amount of \$125,000.00.

The above disciplinary action taken by the sister state of New York provides grounds to take disciplinary action against Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(e), in that, Respondent has engaged in

professional misconduct. It appearing that Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without formal proceedings and for good cause shown,

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS on this 21 day of August, 2006,
ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey is hereby suspended for a period of 24 months, with said suspension to be entirely stayed, and Respondent placed on probation for a period of 36 months. Said probationary period shall be retroactive to and run concurrently with the 36 month probation period issued by the sister state of New York by entry of the April 3, 2006, Consent Order.


2. Respondent shall provide proof of successful completion of the 140 hours of continuing medical education mandated by the New York Board for Professional Medical Conduct by entry of the April 3, 2006, Consent Order. These 140 hours of continuing medical education shall be in addition to those hours required for renewal of licensure in the State of New Jersey.

3. Respondent shall maintain active registration of his license in the State of New Jersey and shall pay all registration fees associated with his license.
