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This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Chiropractic Examiners (hereinafter, the "Board") upon the filing of a Verified Complaint alleging health care claims fraud and obtaining Controlled Dangerous Substance by fraud and seeking the suspension or revocation of the license of Respondent to practice Chiropractic and for such other relief deemed appropriate, pursuant to the authority conferred on the Board by N.J.S.A. 45:9-41.4 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 45:1-14 et seq. and related Administrative regulations.

On June 22, 2000, an Interim Consent Order was filed wherein Respondent without an admission of wrong doing, voluntarily agreed to cease practicing Chiropractic in the State of New Jersey.

After nearly four years, on or about February 13, 2004, Respondent, through his counsel, John E. Tiffany, Esq., petitioned the Board for reinstatement of his New Jersey Chiropractic license. On February 26, 2004, Respondent appeared before the Board and demonstrated his fitness to resume the practice of Chiropractic, submitted documentation of his current medical treatment for Crohns Disease, continuing education, and past employment.

After reviewing the available information and Respondent's testimony, by Order dated March 18, 2004, the Board reinstated the license of Richard J. Herbert, D.C. to practice Chiropractic in the State of New Jersey.

The Board is satisfied that good cause exists to enter into the within resolution of the Verified Complaint and that the within Order is adequately productive of the public health, safety and welfare;

IT IS on this 8 day of Sept. 2006,


ORDERED that:

1. Respondent, Richard J. Herbert, D.C., shall pay for costs of this investigation in the amount of \$518.32 by certified check or money order payable to the Board of Chiropractic Examiners and sent to the attention of the Executive Director, Kevin Earle, 124 Halsey

Street, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, Newark, New Jersey 07101. The payment shall be made in full within ten days from the date of entry of this Order. The Board reserves the right to file a certificate of debt in the event payment in full is not received.


2. All allegations in the Verified Complaint are finally resolved by entry of this Order.
