Administrative Action

INTERIM CONSENT ORDER

This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Respiratory Care (Board) upon receipt of information from St. Francis Medical Center, Trenton, NJ alleging that on August 29, 2006, Richard Krauszer (Respondent) was missing from the Intensive Care Unit during the night shift, failed to respond to a "code", and diverted Diprivan from an Intravenous Unit. Thereafter, Respondent was terminated from St. Francis Medical Center. Through Respondent's counsel and the Professional Assistance Program of New Jersey (PAP) the Board was advised on or about September 8, 2006, that Respondent on or about September 12, 2006, will voluntarily admit himself into His Laboring Few Ministries of Jesus Christ Trinity, located

in North Carolina, an inpatient facility, for treatment of depression and relapse prevention, for a minimum of three (3) months. Respondent is presently undergoing monitoring by the PAP.

The Board and Respondent seek to resolve this matter on an interim basis without resort to further proceedings, on condition that Respondent agrees not to practice respiratory care in New Jersey until further order of this Board. The Board reserving the right to take further action, and finding the within Order is sufficiently protective of the public interest and for good cause shown.

IT IS ON THIS 25th DAY OF Sept. 2006, ORDERED THAT:

1. Effective immediately and until further order of the Board, Respondent voluntarily agrees to, and shall immediately surrender his license and cease and desist the practice of respiratory care in the State of New Jersey; and

2. Respondent shall immediately forward his original New Jersey respiratory care license and biennial renewal card to Dorcas O'Neal, Executive Director, New Jersey State Board of Respiratory Care, P. O. Box 45031, 124 Halsey Street, Sixth Floor, Newark, New Jersey 07101; and

3. Prior to any application to resume the practice of Respiratory Care, Respondent shall provide to the Board copies of his treatment records and discharge summary from His Laboring Few Ministries of Jesus Christ Trinity Behavioral Health in North Carolina regarding his inpatient treatment as soon as he is discharged


