This matter was reopened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners (the "Board") upon the petition of Respondent, Chidi I. Anukwuem, M.D. for an unrestricted license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey. In accordance with a Consent Order filed September 22, 2003, Dr. Anukwuem's license to practice medicine and surgery was suspended for a total of six (6) months which was stayed in its entirety on the condition that he serves a two year period of probation. Said probationary period has been satisfied. Further, during the period of stayed suspension, Respondent was required to take and successfully complete course work in pharmacology, infectious disease, medical record keeping and ethics. Respondent satisfied all medical education requirements prior to October 18, 2005. The conduct that gave rise to the 2003 consent order was excessive prescribing of Serostim.

The Board is satisfied that Respondent has complied with all terms and conditions imposed upon his license by the terms of the prior Order. Therefore, the Board concludes that good cause exists at this time to restore Respondent's licensure status to "unrestricted" licensure.

ORDERED:

1. The license of Chidi I. Anukwuem, M.D. to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey is hereby deemed unrestricted.
