**FINAL ORDER
BY CONSENT**

TO PRACTICE MEDICINE AND SURGERY
IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY

This matter was opened before the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners (the "Board") upon receipt of investigative information indicating that Mario Palacios, M.D. was engaged in an unlawful financial and/or billing relationship with one or more Chiropractic practitioners in violation of N.J.S.A. 45:9-1 et seq. and/or the regulations promulgated thereunder, N.J.A.C. 13:35-6.16(f)(3).

Dr. Palacios being desirous of resolving this matter without the need for further proceedings and the Board having found the within disposition adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare,

IT IS on this 15 day of Nov, 2006

CERTIFIED TRUE COPY

ORDERED as follows:

1. Mario E. Palacios, M.D., is hereby granted leave to voluntarily and permanently retire his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey;
2. Upon receipt of a filed copy of this Consent Order, Dr. Palacios shall immediately return his original New Jersey Controlled Dangerous Substance ("CDS") registration, his original New Jersey medical license and current biennial registration to the Board;
3. Dr. Palacios shall permanently cease and desist from prescribing or dispensing any medications, including CDS, to any individual, including himself, his family members or his patients and immediately advise the New Jersey Office of Drug Control and the Drug Enforcement Agency of this Order;
4. Dr. Palacios shall comply with the "Directives" attached hereto as Exhibit A which are incorporated herein by reference; and
5. Respondent acknowledges that he has been specifically advised of his right to have this Consent Order reviewed by an attorney of his choosing. Respondent enters this Consent Order knowingly and voluntarily and acknowledges that there have been no other representations or agreements not stated in writing herein.
