



Dr. Hamada now seeks leave to wind down the operation of his medical practice and permanently retire from the practice of medicine in New Jersey. Dr. Hamada is entering into this Consent Order to fully resolve all outstanding investigations of the State Board of Medical Examiners. The Board finding the within disposition adequately protective of the public health, safety, and welfare, and other good cause having been shown,

IT IS, therefore, on this 13<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2006,

ORDERED AND AGREED THAT:

1. Kunikata Hamada, M.D., is hereby granted leave and shall surrender his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey effective January 1, 2007. Said surrender shall be deemed a revocation of his license with prejudice to any future reapplication for licensure.
2. Dr. Hamada immediately shall cease and desist from authorizing any prescriptions for CDS.
3. Dr. Hamada shall return his original New Jersey medical license and any biennial registration cards in his possession to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners, Post Office Box 183, Trenton, New Jersey 08625-0183, within five (5) days of January 1, 2007.
4. Dr. Hamada immediately shall return his original State CDS registration to the New Jersey State Board of Medical

Examiners, Post Office Box 183, Trenton, New Jersey  
08625-0183.

5. Dr. Hamada immediately shall send all of his remaining prescription blanks, along with a cover memorandum indicating that he no longer will be writing prescriptions and asking that his prescription blanks be destroyed pursuant to standard operating procedures, to Cathy Collins, Executive Officer, Enforcement Bureau Drug Control Unit, P.O. Box 45022, Newark, New Jersey 07101. Dr. Hamada shall send a copy of the transmittal letter to Ms. Collins required herein to Deputy Attorney General Tara Ragone, Division of Law, State of New Jersey, 124 Halsey Street, 5th Floor, P.O. Box 45029, Newark, New Jersey 07101.
6. Dr. Hamada agrees not to reapply for a New Jersey medical license or to seek a CDS registration in New Jersey in the future.
7. Dr. Hamada immediately shall notify the Drug Enforcement Administration ("DEA") of the entry of the within Order and provide proof of such notification to the Board.
8. Dr. Hamada shall comply with the attached "Directives Applicable to Any Medical Board Licensee Who Is Disciplined or Whose Surrender of Licensure Has Been

Accepted," which Directives are incorporated herein by reference.
