This matter was opened to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners (Board) upon receipt of information that Tobias Shklover, M.D., (Respondent) surrendered his license to practice medicine in New York on or about May 19, 2006. The New York Department of Health, State Board For Professional Conduct (New York Board) filed the Surrender Order on or about May 19, 2006 based upon Respondent's guilty plea and conviction in Westchester County, New York, of insurance fraud in the second degree, in violation of New York Penal Law Section 176.25, a class C felony.

CERTIFIED TRUE COPY

Respondent's guilty plea, conviction and surrender of his New York license provide a basis for disciplinary action pursuant to N.J.S.A. 45:1-21(f) and (g).

The Board and Respondent seek to resolve this matter without resorting to further proceedings, therefore, Respondent now seeks leave to voluntarily surrender his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey with prejudice in accordance with the terms of this Order. The Board finding the within disposition to be adequately protective of the public health, safety and welfare;

IT IS, therefore, on this 8th day of Jan, 2007, ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent, Tobias Shklover, M.D. shall immediately surrender his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of New Jersey with prejudice to any re-application.

2. Respondent shall return his original New Jersey license and most recent biennial registration to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners, contemporaneously with his signing of this Order.

3. Respondent shall return his original New Jersey CDS registration to the New Jersey State Board of Medical Examiners, contemporaneously with his signing of this Order.

4. Respondent shall immediately advise the DEA of this Order.

5. Respondent shall comply with the attached Directives for Physicians whose Surrender of Licensure has been Accepted by the Board, which are incorporated herein by reference.

6. The parties hereby stipulate that entry of this Order is

without prejudice to further action by other law enforcement entities or other governmental agencies resulting from Respondent's conduct.
