applicant. Respondent is not licensed as a Professional Counselor, as a social worker or as a health care provider in the State of New Jersey.

On October 16, 2005 respondent sent a letter to the Committee admitting that she "did fill out paperwork representing myself as a licensed professional counselor... ."

It appearing that the respondent desires to resolve this matter without further proceedings, and the Committee finding this Consent Order to be adequately protective of the public interest, and other good cause appearing;

IT IS THEREFORE ON THIS 25th DAY OF April, 2007

ORDERED:


1. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from using the title or designation "professional counselor" or "LPC" or any title or designation by which respondent represents herself as a professional counselor unless and until she is licensed or certified by the Board.

2. Respondent shall cease and desist from offering or engaging in the supervision of any mental health counseling unless and until she is licensed by the Board or otherwise licensed or certified in the State of New Jersey to provide mental health counseling.

3. Respondent shall cease and desist from offering or engaging in any mental health counseling unless and until she is licensed by


